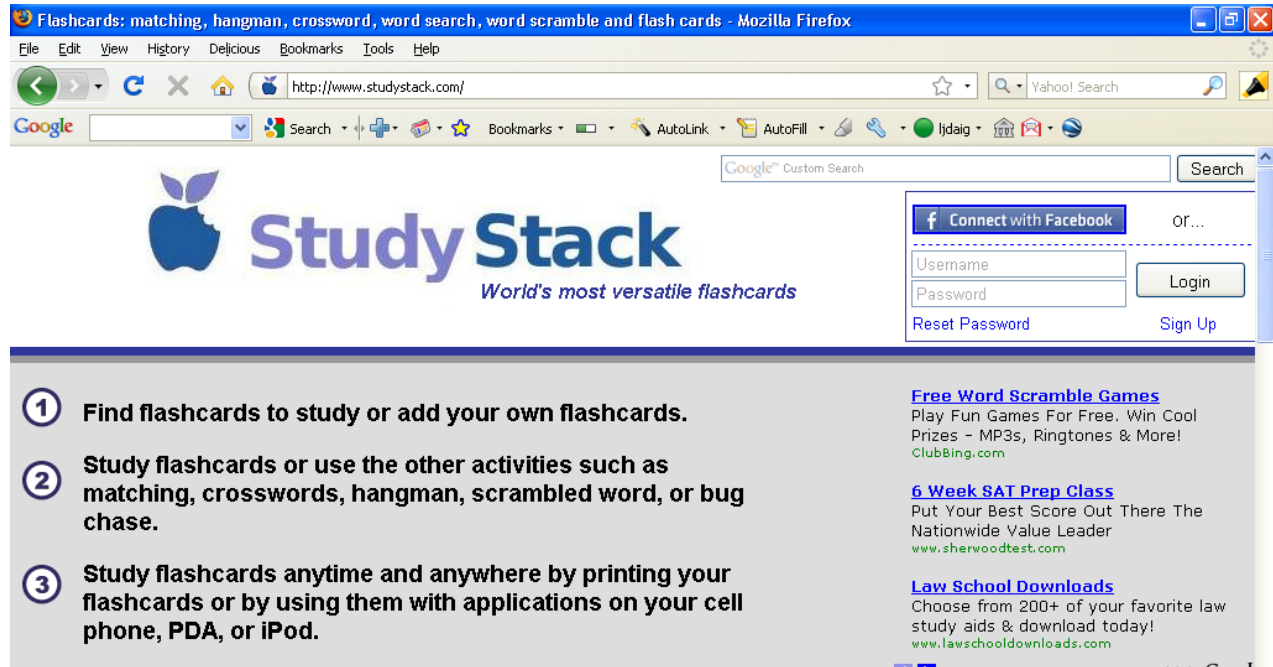


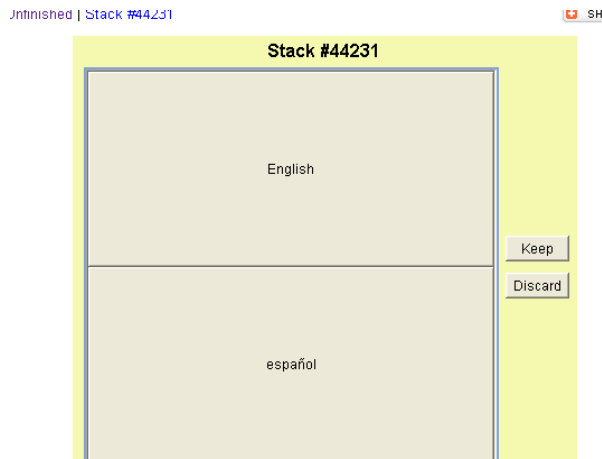



Save Changes

An alternative way of adding cards, is to import a block of text. By default, each line of text should be for one card. The parts of that card (i.e. question and answer) must be separated by a delimiter, such as a comma or equal sign. Whatever you use as the delimiter should not appear anywhere else in the data. You may use any editor you like to create this text. When you are ready to import the text, copy and paste it into the space below. Then specify what the delimiter characters are and click on the Import button. The text you entered will be parsed and added to the blanks above. (Additional rows will be added if necessary.) After your data is imported, review the table above to make sure that your data is being parsed properly, and then click on the "Save Changes" button to have your data copied to the StudyStack server.

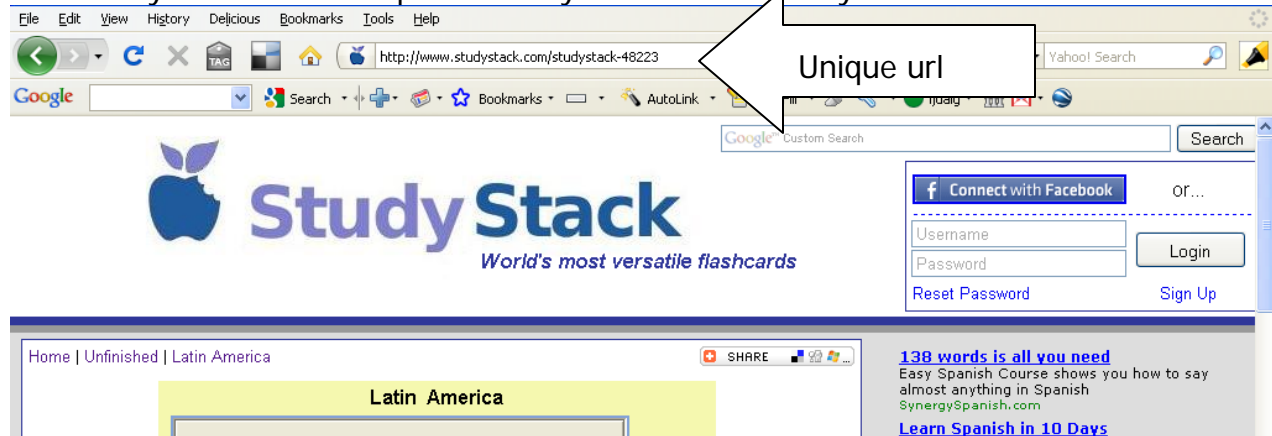

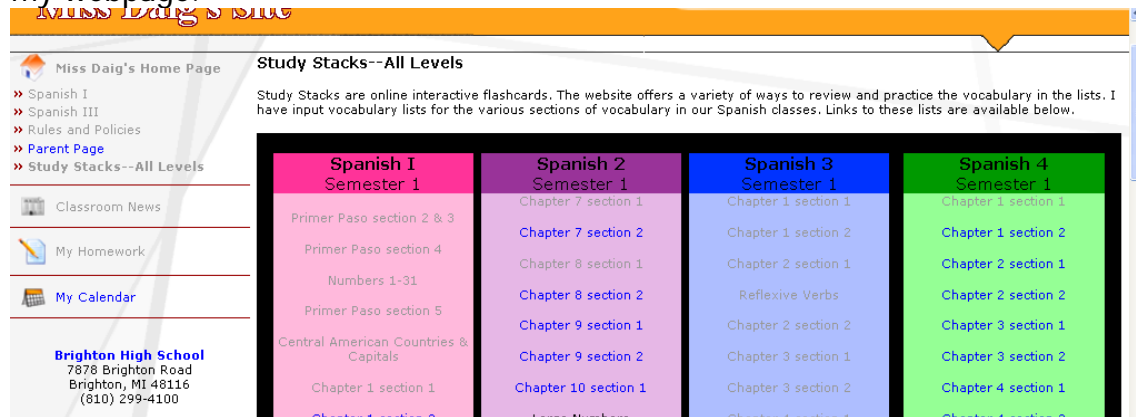
## Sharing your Study Stacks

If you assigned your stack to a category, your students can find your site through browsing. However, with the number of stacks available, this is probably not the most efficient way to share them.

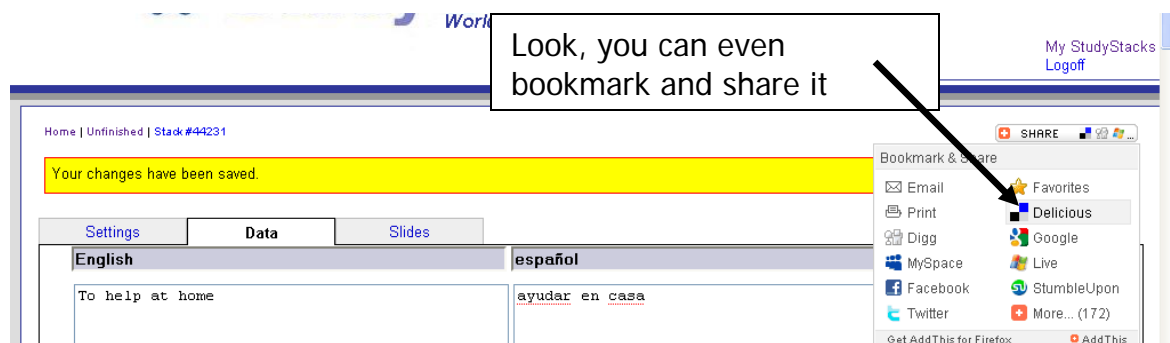
Each study stack has a unique url that you can share with your students.
