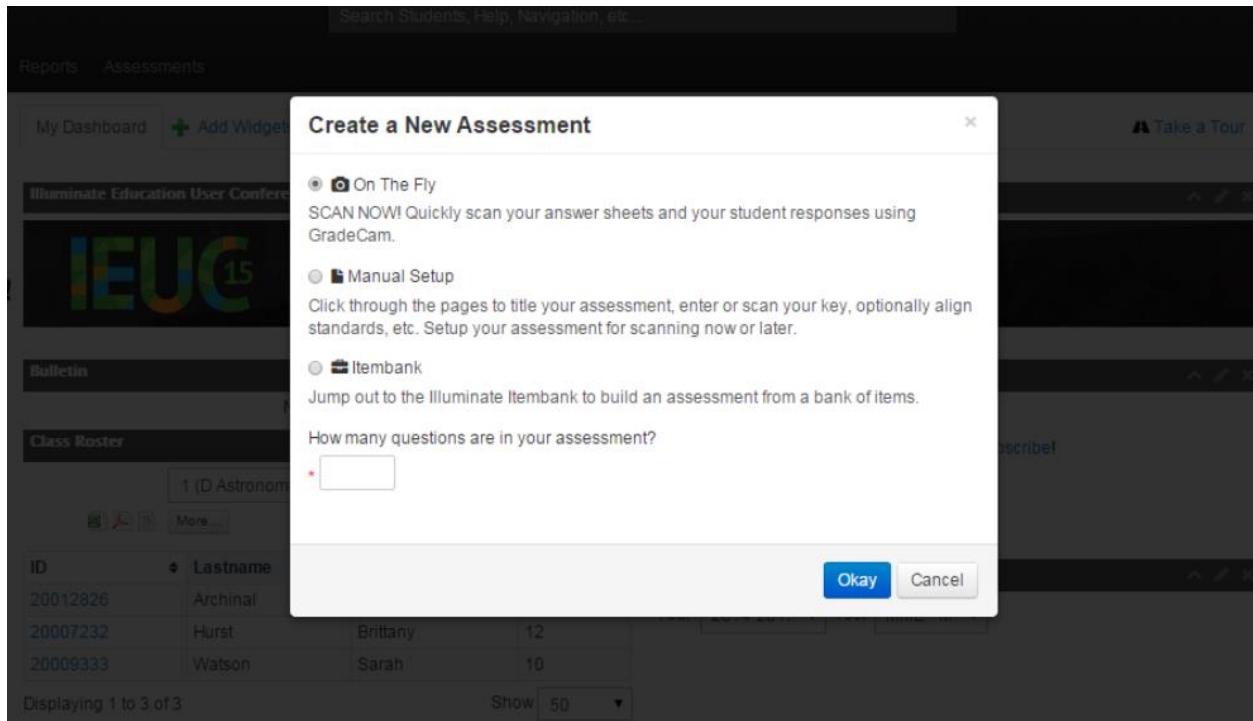




BHS Illuminate Help Sheet: Types of Assessments

There are three types of assessments in Illuminate: On the Fly, Manual Setup and Itembank.



On The Fly: This assessment requires the least amount of prep work. All you need to do prior to giving the assessment is print off answer sheets for your students. The assessment uses standard multiple choice answer sheets. After you scan the student answer sheets, you can save the assessment. Once the assessment is saved, you can align your questions to standards and run analytics.

Manual Setup: Create the assessment in Illuminate prior to administering the assessment. Assessments with manual setup allow you to customize answer documents by changing the number of choices, renaming the choices, or changing the size of the answers. Manual set-up also allows you to incorporate rubric scored questions and align your questions to standards prior to giving the assessment. Manual set-up assessments do not include the actual questions. You will still use a separate test booklet with the questions.

Itembank: Itembank assessments require the most prepwork. For an itembank assessment, the questions themselves are actually in Illuminate. You may either select items from an existing bank, or create the questions in the Itembank program. Itembank assessments may be set-up to be administered online, or you may print out the assessments.



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
